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#### Museums and galleries

##### Introduction

The chart compares and contrasts the most popular English museums and galleries. Judging by the number of visits we can come up to some conclusions and make some assumptions.

##### General tendencies

The number of visits to the British Museum, the National Gallery and the Tate Gallery has significantly increased during the period from 2013 to 2017. While the other museums have lost a number of visitors. 1.8 mln visitors for the ~~National~~ Natural History Museum and 2.2 mln for the Science Museum respectively.

##### Statistics analysis

If we compare the two galleries, we will notice that the Tate Gallery has gained more visitors than the National Gallery in percentage. The difference is about 10%.

Taking a closer look at the statistics for 2017 we see that the number of visits has increased for every single museum or gallery. Moreover, the more expensive it is to enter a museum, the less people will attend it, this rule definitely appeals to the museums of Natural History and Science.

##### Recommendations

I find it smart to stop charging entrance fee so that to have a substantial part of visitors back. Moreover, museums should care about their young visitors more by, for instance, providing some pencils and paper to draw on. This may attract a lot of children and, of course, their parents.
